



Dear parents/guardians of Grade 10 and 11 learners

### **RETURN TO SCHOOL: 6 JULY 2020**

We are excited to welcome back the rest of our senior learners on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July 2020. The Grade 12s have been back at school for four weeks. We can report that, even under the new circumstances, it is an absolute pleasure to teach them. We have, once again, come to the realisation that there truly is no replacement for education within the confines of a classroom!

### **ARRANGEMENTS FOR 6 JULY 2020**

#### **GRADE 11s**

- Learners arrive at school from 07:00. Screening will be conducted at the bridge leading to the woodwork quad.
- Learners must have the following with them:
  - Their own pen, since they will need to complete a form stating that they are healthy.
  - A mask with which they have travelled from home.
  - The electronic device (cell phone / laptop) they have used to work on at home.
- We understand that learners are excited to see each other after such a long period of time. However, a safe distance of 1,5 metres between learners must be maintained at ALL times. NO hugs, “fist bumps”, handshakes, etc. will be allowed.
- Each learner’s temperature will be measured with an electronic thermometer and captured on a class list.
- Learners will then be sent to specific classrooms where the orientation process will occur.
- Grade 11s will be dismissed in groups from 10:15 – 10:45 (please see the attached schedule). Learners must vacate the school premises immediately via the same entrance through which they entered (the doors at the bridge leading to the woodwork quad).
- Classrooms will be sanitised directly after learners are dismissed.

#### **GRADE 10s**

- Learners report at the ramp in front of the tuck shop at 10:15.
- Learners must have the following with them:
  - Their own pen, since they will need to complete a form stating that they are healthy.
  - A mask with which they have travelled from home.
  - The electronic device (cell phone / laptop) they have used to work on at home.
- We understand that learners are excited to see each other after such a long period of time. However, a safe distance of 1,5 metres between learners must be maintained at ALL times. NO hugs, “fist bumps”, handshakes, etc. will be allowed.
- Each learner’s temperature will be measured with an electronic thermometer and captured on a class list.
- Learners will then be sent to specific classrooms where the orientation process will occur.
- Grade 10s will be dismissed in groups from 13:30 (please see the attached schedule). Learners must vacate the school premises immediately via the same entrance through which they entered (at the tuck shop).
- Classrooms will be sanitised directly after learners are dismissed.



To ensure social distancing within classrooms, a maximum of 25 learners will be allowed per class. Only half the learners from each register class will attend school daily. Please consult the timetable below to see when your child must attend school.

Normal school hours apply from Monday to Friday (07:45 – 14:30). Learners will be dismissed in groups each day.

### RESTROOMS

- A maximum of three learners will be allowed per restroom.
- Grade 12s will use the restrooms next to Room 26.
- Grade 11s will use the restrooms near Room 21 on the first floor.
- Grade 10 girls will use the restroom near Room 4 on the ground floor.
- Grade 10 boys will use the restroom in the lab corridor.
- Please follow the procedure displayed in the restrooms.
- Wait on the distance markers in the passages outside the restrooms until someone exits.
- If learners do not have enough time to visit restrooms during breaks, they will be allowed to do so during periods.

### PROCESS AT EACH CLASS

- Learners do not wait in the passages outside classrooms.
- Learners must sit at the same desk every day.
- Learners must disinfect their hands before entering classrooms.
- Learners must disinfect their desks at the end of every period.
- NO stationery may be borrowed from or lent to one another.
- NO water may be drunk during periods.
- Learners must wear masks at all times. They are more effective than face shields. Teachers, however, wear face shields, because it makes it easier for learners to hear them.
- The first period's teacher will be in his/her classroom from 07:40 to receive learners. Social distancing must be maintained outside the classroom.



### **DRESS CODE / APPEARANCE**

- No specific colour is prescribed for masks.
- Learners must wear a clean mask every day and always bring an extra one to school.
- On Mondays, learners must wear their full winter school uniform.
- During the rest of the week, learners may wear clean civvies. They must look presentable at all times (no torn jeans and/or casual sportswear).
- Learners may wear their school tracksuits, but not on a daily basis (this provides parents with the opportunity to wash it regularly).
- The usual dress code rules still apply to hair (short, neat and fastened), earrings, etc.

### **FOOD PROJECT**

- Please report any needs to the grade heads. You do not need to feel ashamed to admit that your family is struggling — there are currently many families in the same boat.

### **COUNSELLING**

- Learners must inform their grade heads if they are anxious or if they have other uncertainties.
- Mrs Fourie ([rfourie@hstygerberg.co.za](mailto:rfourie@hstygerberg.co.za)) will assist learners with any problems they are experiencing.
- Be sensitive to others' fears. There are learners and teachers who can be affected by COVID-19, because of their underlying comorbidities.

### **BE ADAPTABLE**

- Maintain a positive attitude. We cannot cancel the rest of the academic year!
- There is no point in feeling angry — no one chose these circumstances.
- We would like to help you — we are on your side.

### **SIGNING OUT**

- If you feel ill and are displaying COVID-19-related symptoms, inform your class teacher immediately.
- Mrs Roberts or Mr Carstens will contact your parent/guardian.
- If you need to sign out for other reasons during the school day, the normal signing out procedure applies.

### **SCHOOL TERMS FOR 2020**

- Term 2: 6 July – 7 August
- Term 3: 12 August – 23 September
- Term 4: 5 October – 15 December

### **ACADEMICS**

- We assume that all learners remained up to date with their schoolwork during the lockdown period.
- The curriculum will be completed in class.
- Learners who need academic support will be assisted during PT periods and after school.
- Learners will NOT be promoted automatically at the end of the year.



### **ENSURE YOUR SAFETY**

- Wear your mask at ALL times. Only remove it when you are eating during breaktime.
- Do not touch your mask unnecessarily or place it on any surface.
- Keep a safe distance (1.5 metres) between yourself and another person – ESPECIALLY during breaktime.
- Disinfect your hands before and after each class as well as after each restroom visit.
- Do not borrow anything from someone or lend your belongings to someone.
- Clean your phone regularly.
- Do not touch common surfaces (e.g. railings, walls, etc.).
- If someone else does not comply with the protocol, remind him/her to do so.
- Shower immediately when you arrive home and wash your clothing and mask. Remember: you may NOT wear the same clothes and mask to school each day.

### **WHAT IF THE SCHOOL CLOSES AGAIN?**

- We do not expect this to happen. If learners have to stay at home, we will use MS Teams to provide online education. Therefore, learners must be in a position to engage online.
- All learners must ensure that they can access their SCHOOL email addresses. This will be the primary means of communication. Parents also need to ensure that they know how to access these email addresses. It is important to keep passwords safe.
- Teachers will help all learners to master this process on their first day back at school. If you have any problems, please contact Mrs Nel ([bnel@hstygerberg.co.za](mailto:bnel@hstygerberg.co.za)) or Mrs Rossouw ([wrossouw@hstygerberg.co.za](mailto:wrossouw@hstygerberg.co.za)).
- In exceptional cases other arrangements will be made to download information or to share hard copies. All learners will be able to gain access to the school's network so that they can download the necessary work during school hours.
- Every teacher needs the learner's and parent's/guardian's contact details.
- Formal assessment tasks must be completed AT SCHOOL and CANNOT be submitted electronically. There are not enough supervisors and venues available to accommodate everyone separately.
- If you do not have a complete SBA mark, you cannot write the November exams.

### **WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DISPLAY SYMPTOMS OR FEEL SICK?**

- Do not come to school.
- Inform your grade head immediately.
- Visit a doctor.
- If the doctor says you can come back to school, please bring the medical certificate along.
- If you are tested for COVID-19, stay at home until you have received your test results (remember to bring proof of the test results to school).
- Try to stay up to date with your academics.



### WHAT HAPPENS IF A TEACHER/OTHER LEARNER IS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?

- The learner/teacher may only return to school if he/she has tested negative for COVID-19.
- All individuals who were in **close** contact with the person must isolate for 14 days.
- Other learners/teachers will still come to school.
- The principal may not decide to close the school.
- The Department of Education will decide whether it is necessary for the school to close.
- There is a distinction between **casual contact** (where everybody is in the same room, but all individuals wore masks and maintained a social distance of more than 1.5 metres) and **close contact** (where physical contact occurred for more than 15 minutes without wearing a mask) with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Individuals who have had **casual contact** with such a person may continue as per usual.
- Individuals who have had **close contact** with such a person must isolate for 14 days and monitor themselves for symptoms. They may only return to school if they are healthy.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The tuck shop will be closed and learners must bring their own refreshments from home.
- No ball games or other physical activities will be allowed during or after school hours. Furthermore, learners may not play Dominoes or card games during breaks or after school.
- Learners must answer the following questions honestly every day:
  - Do you have a sore throat?
  - Do you have a fever?
  - Do you have a persistent cough?
  - Are you experiencing shortness of breath?
  - Have you been in **close contact** with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 over the last 14 days?
- Deliberately withholding this information or being dishonest endangers other people's lives and is considered a serious offence.
- Learners who have any of these symptoms must stay home and inform the school.
- However, learners should also not be kept at home for no reason. This can have a negative impact on their academic progress. As a result they may not be promoted.
- ALL formal assessment tasks must be completed at the school, even if the learner has a comorbidity (refer to Letter 5 from the principal).


